

Study the pictures below and answer the following questions.










Complete the following table with reference to the above pictures. Some answers have been given as examples.

For example:

Pottinger Street was the first street named after a governor. It was also called Stone-board Street (石板街) because it was the only street at the time to be built from stone boards. The pictures show Pottinger Street in early 20th century (left) and today (right).



Stone - board street originly named Pottinger street. Is a street builded by stone-board. In the past there is a lot of shops in the street but now there are only a few shops left in Stone - board street. Pottinger struet was named by the first garant in Hong Kong.
