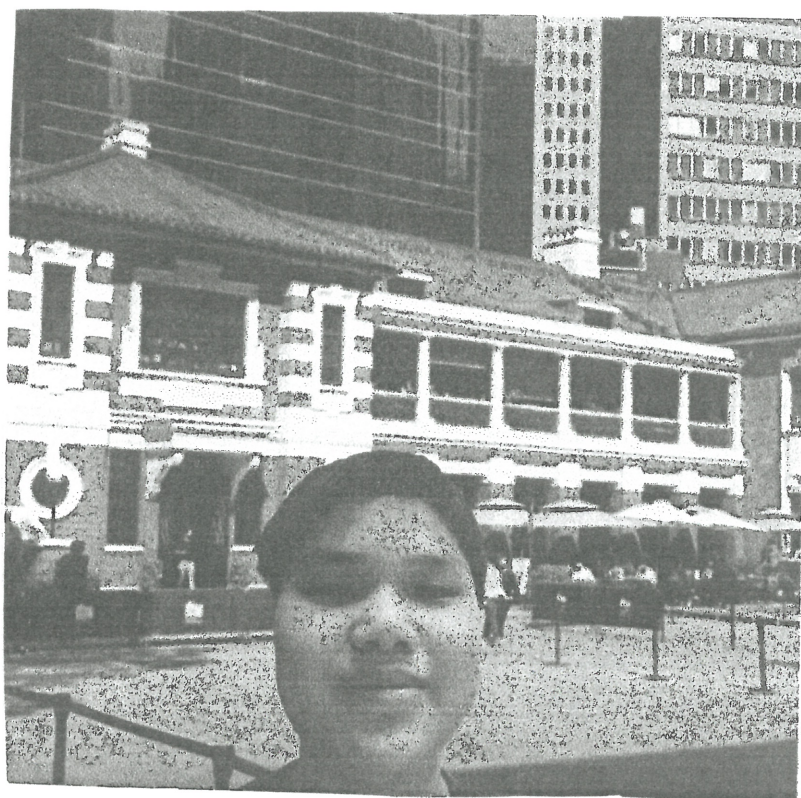
1. Find a photo of the street/historical building that were taken in the past, say 50 to 100 years ago, on the Internet/in the history books.





2. **Take a selfie in a street/historical building OR Photoshop yourself into the picture that tell us about the history of Hong Kong.**

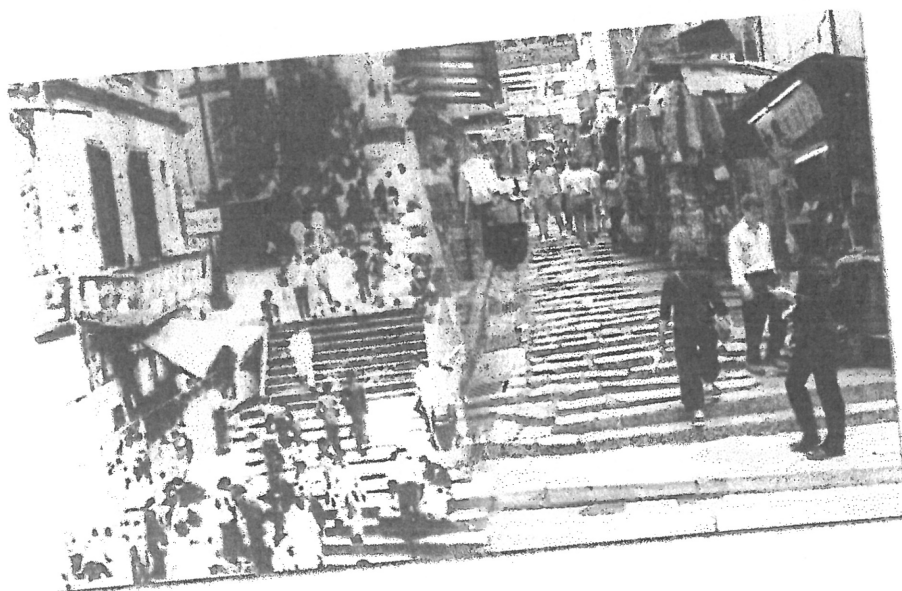

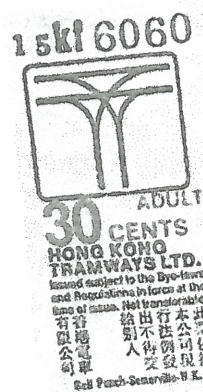


### Description of your photo

It is Tai Kuan, The Old Central Police Station, located on Hollywood Road, Central, Hong Kong, used to be the Hong Kong Police Headquarters and the Central Police Station. The Central Police Station has now been relocated to adjacent to the Central Police District Headquarters on Central Hong Kong Road in Sheung Wan. The original site, together with the former Central Magistracy, are now declared monuments in Hong Kong.
